

Option Packages to Key Management

The Board of Jupiter Energy Limited (ASX: JPR) advises that Incentive Option Packages have been agreed with the following key personnel:

- Ole Udsen (Country Manager – Kazakhstan)
- Keith Martens (Technical Consultant)
- Sergey Sinitsin (Business Development Consultant)

Each individual will have an option package that will be issued in 2 tranches with each tranche being 5 million options (ie for a total of 10 million options each). The options will be unlisted with an exercise price of 8 cents and an expiry date of June 30 2011. The options will vest on the following terms:

- 25% of the allocation will vest 12 months from the date of issue
- 75% of the allocation will vest 24 months from the date of issue

In order for the options to vest, the individual must still be contracted by JPR at the date that the options are due to vest. If the individual is not contracted by JPR at the date that the options are due to vest, the options will be cancelled. Each option will cost the individual 0.1 cent. Accordingly, \$30,000 will be raised by the Company by the issue of the options. These funds will be allocated to working capital.

The exercise price of the options reflects the share price of JPR at the time that the incentive packages were initially agreed with the three individuals.

An Appendix 3B for the initial issue of 15 million options is attached to this announcement. A 2nd Appendix 3B for a further 15 million options will be issued in due course, probably before June 30 2008. Each issue of the options will be made within the Company's 15% placement provision. Accordingly, the issue of the options is not subject to shareholder approval.
